

Dear Ms. Perrin:

Reference is made to your application dated February 14, 1990 for a non-standard coal gas well location for your Carracas Unit "23-B" Well No. 15 to be located 1170 feet from the South line and 1510 feet from the East line (Unit O) of Irregular Section 23, Township 32 North, Range 4 West, NMPM, Basin Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. The S/2 of said Section 23 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 8 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8768, the above-described unorthodox coal gas well location is hereby approved.
