
Administrative Order NSL-2783

Dear Ms. Atwater:

Reference is made to your application dated April 12, 1990 for a non-standard infill oil well location to permit the completion of an efficient production/injection pattern within an existing secondary recovery project for your West Pearl Queen Unit Well No. 191 to be located 1310 feet from the South and West lines (Unit M) of Section 28, Township 19 South, Range 35 East, NMPM, Pearl Queen Pool, West Pearl Queen Unit Waterflood Project Area, Lea County, New Mexico. Said well to be dedicated to the existing standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit comprising the SW/4 SW/4 of said Section 28, which is presently dedicated to the West Pearl Unit Well No. 126 located 660 feet from the South and West lines of said Section 28.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of General Rule 104 F(I) and Division Order No. R-2729, as amended, the above-described unorthodox infill oil well location is hereby approved.
