
Dear Ms. Houghton:

Reference is made to your application dated September 6, 1990 for a non-standard Wolfcamp oil well location for your existing 9004 JV-P French Well No. 1 which was drilled in June 1990 to test the Undesignated South Corbin-Morrow Gas Pool at a previously approved (Division Administrative Order NSL-2748, dated April 27, 1990) non-standard gas well location 990 feet from the South and East line (Unit P) of Section 24, Township 18 South, Range 32 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

It is my understanding that the Morrow zone has been properly plugged back and said well will be recompleted in the Undesignated South Corbin-Wolfcamp Pool, which pursuant to the Special Rules and Regulations for the South Corbin-Wolfcamp Pool as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8181-B, is unorthodox. Further, the E/2 SE/4 of said Section 24 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 80-acre oil spacing and proration unit for said pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 5 of said Division Order No. R-8181-B, the above-described unorthodox oil well location is hereby approved.
