Reference is made to your application dated April 19, 1990 for a non-standard oil well location for your M. Dodd "B" Well No. 67 to be located 2615 feet from the South line and 1980 feet from the East line (Unit J) of Section 14, Township 17 South, Range 29 East, NMPM, Grayburg Jackson Seven Rivers Queen Grayburg San Andres Pool, SDX Keeley Waterflood Project, Eddy County, New Mexico.
