
Dear Ms. Bradfield:

Reference is made to your applications dated May 3 and May 7, 1990 for a non-standard Basin-Fruitland coal gas well location for your existing Galt B Well No. 1 which was drilled in 1954 and completed in the Fulcher Kutz Pictured Cliffs Pool at a standard gas well location 1600 feet from the South line and 900 feet from the East line (Unit I) of Section 6, Township 27 North, Range 10 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico.

It is my understanding that the Pictured Cliffs zone will be properly plugged back and said well will be recompleted to the Basin-Fruitland Coal Gas Pool, which pursuant to the Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Fruitland Coal Gas Pool as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8768, is unorthodox. Further, Lots 1 and 2, S/2 NE/4, SE/4 (E/2 equivalent) of said Section 6 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 320.51-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 8 of said Division Order No. R-8768, the above-described unorthodox coal gas well location is hereby approved.
