Dear Mr. Anderson:

Reference is made to your application dated July 6, 1990 for an unorthodox Eumont gas well location in an existing non-standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit (GPU) for said Eumont Gas Pool comprising the N/2 of Section 36, Township 21 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. Said GPU was authorized by Division Administrative Order NSP-310, dated August 31, 1956 and presently has dedicated thereon the Harry Leonard (NCT-C) Well Nos. 7, 8 and 9 located respectively in Units G, H and B of said Section 36.

It is our understanding that the subject well in this application is currently completed in the Arrowhead Grayburg Pool, however, said well will be plugged back to the Eumont Gas Pool upon issuance of this order.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 2(c) of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Eumont Gas Pool, as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, the following described well located at an unorthodox gas well location is hereby approved:

Also, you are hereby authorized to simultaneously dedicate Eumont Gas production from the Harry Leonard (NCT-C) Well No. 4 with the Harry Leonard (NCT-C) Well Nos. 7, 8 and 9. Furthermore, you are hereby permitted to produce the allowable assigned the subject GPU from all of said wells in any proportion.
