Reference is made to your application on behalf of Nearburg Producing Company dated August 24, 1990 for a non-standard oil well location for your Western "F" Well No. 1 to be located 2130 feet from the North and West lines (Unit F) of Section 17, Township 16 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Northeast Lovington Pennsylvanian Pool, Lea County, New Mexico. The S/2 NW/4 of said Section 17 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 80-acre oil spacing and proration unit for said pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 5 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Northeast Lovington Pennsylvanian Pool, as promulgated by Division Order No. R-3816, as amended, the above-described unorthodox oil well location is hereby approved.
