Reference is made to your application dated September 5, 1990 for a non-standard oil well location to permit the completion of an efficient production/injection pattern within an active secondary recovery project for your Lovington San Andres Unit Well No. 62 to be located 1185 feet from the North line and 152 feet from the East line (Unit A) of Section 2, Township 17 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lovington Grayburg San Andres Pool, Lovington San Andres Unit Waterflood Project Area, Lea County, New Mexico.
