Dear Ms. Bradfield:

Reference is made to your application dated September 12, 1990 for a non-standard coal gas well location for your Rosa Unit Well No. 265 to be located 2075 feet from the North line and 1990 feet from the East line (Unit G) of Section 27, Township 31 North, Range 5 West, NMPM, Basin Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. The E/2 of said Section 27 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 8 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8768, the above-described unorthodox coal gas well location is hereby approved.
