Dear Mr. Sanders:

Reference is made to your application dated September 29, 1990 for a non-standard coal gas well location for your San Juan 29-5 Unit Well No. 224 to be located 1293 feet from the South line and 736 feet from the West line (Unit M) of Section 23, Township 29 North, Range 5 West, NMPM, Basin Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. The W/2 of said Section 23 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.
