Reference is made to your application dated August 28, 1990 for a non-standard gas well location for your Fullerton Federal "33" Well No. 14 to be located 2420 feet from the South line and 1995 feet from the East line (Unit J) of Section 14, Township 27 North, Range 11 West, NMPM, West Kutz Pictured Cliffs Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico. The SE/4 of said Section 14 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 160-acre gas spacing and proration unit.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of General Rule 104F.I. the above-described unorthodox gas well location is hereby approved.
