Dear Mr. Williams:

Reference is made to your application dated September 5, 1990 for a non-standard gas well location for your Gallegos Canyon Unit Well No. 511 to be located 745 feet from the North line and 1080 feet from the West line (Unit D) of Section 26, Township 29 North, Range 12 West, NMPM, to test either the Undesignated West Kutz Pictured Cliffs Pool or the Undesignated Fulcher Kutz Pictured Cliffs Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico. The NW/4 equivalent of said Section 26 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 160-acre, more or less, gas spacing and proration unit for either pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of General Rule 104F.I. the above-described unorthodox gas well location is hereby approved.
