Dear Mr. O'Hare:

Reference is made to your application dated October 5, 1990 for a non-standard coal gas well location for your Hammond W.N. Federal Well No. 10 to be located 690 feet from the South line and 1145 feet from the West line (Unit M) of Section 26, Township 27 North, Range 8 West, NMPM, Basin Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico. The W/2 of said Section 26 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 8 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8768, the above-described unorthodox coal gas well location is hereby approved.
