

PROBABLE: Investigation ongoing. Initial accounts indicate that during pigging operations, a vapor cloud formed and ignited causing a fire. Ignit source is unknown at this time. One DCP employee is in critical condition and has been transported to Lubbock Burn Center. At this time, no report liquids being released.

DCP contacted Mike Bratcher and Gerry Guye of the OCD Artesia District. Mike Bratcher indicated he would provide notification to Wayne Price - Environmental Bureau Chief.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.\*

Emergency services were notified and injured individual was transported to Carlsbad Hospital and airlifted to the Lubbock Burn Center. Firefighters extinguished the fire.
