Leonard - Here are the clarifications you asked for:

- Drum Storage Area A is the former acid dock and wash bay area converted into drum storage with concrete floors and a 3 ft wall surrounding the approximately 30 ft x 60 ft area. The former sump was filled in place with concrete and an access ramp was added with a 0.5 ft lip at this point. This area is a secondary storage area and is only utilized when Area B is full.
- Drum Storage Area B is an asphalt floor and concrete bermed area measuring 85.5 ft long x 67 ft wide x 0.5 ft deep.
- Drum Storage Area C & D, all drums in these areas are kept in prefabricated fiberglass containments that are one foot deep.
- Chemical Storage Building is a metal, three sided building with a floor and is 20 ft x 20 ft.
- No sumps are associated with any of these areas
