Dear Mr. Nearburg:

Reference is made to your application dated October 26, 1990 for a non-standard gas well location for your Amethyst State Com Well No. 1 to be located 1880 feet from the North line and 990 feet from the West line (Unit E) of Section 32, Township 24 South, Range 29 East, NMPM, to test the Undesignated Rustler Bluff-Atoka and Morrow Gas Pools, Eddy County, New Mexico. The N/2 of said Section 32 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of General Rule 104.F.I and II the above-described unorthodox gas well location is hereby approved.
