Dear Mr. Martin:

Reference is made to your application dated October 12, 1990 for a non-standard oil well location to permit the completion of an efficient production/injection pattern within an existing secondary recovery project for your Miller "B" Federal Well No. 3 to be located 990 feet from the North line and 1295 feet from the East line (Unit A) of Section 23, Township 17 South, Range 32 East, NMPM, Maljamar Grayburg-San Andres Pool, Maljamar Cooperative Agreement Unit Project Area, Lea County, New Mexico. Said well to be dedicated to the existing standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit comprising the NE/4 NE/4 of said Section 23.
