

Dear Mr. Newport:

Reference is made to your application dated November 1, 1990 for a non-standard oil well location to permit the completion of an efficient production/injection pattern within an existing secondary recovery project for your Eunice Monument Well No. 41 to be located 1275 feet from the South line and 1000 feet from the West line (Unit M) of Section 19, Township 20 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Eunice Monument Grayburg San Andres Pool, Eunice Monument Unit Project Area, Lea County, New Mexico. Said well to be dedicated to the existing standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit comprising the SW/4 SW/4 of said Section 19.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of General Rule 104 F(I) and Division Order No. R-3986, the above-described unorthodox oil well location is hereby approved.
