Dear Mr. Kellahin:

Reference is made to your application dated December 10, 1990 for two non-standard oil well locations to permit the completion of an efficient production/injection pattern in Section 29, Township 17 South, Range 31 East, NMPM, Grayburg-Jackson Pool, Turner "B" Grayburg Jackson Waterflood Project Area, Eddy County, New Mexico. Both wells to be dedicated to an existing standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit comprising the NE/4 NW/4 (Unit C) of said Section 29, which is presently dedicated to the Socorro Petroleum Company Turner "B" (B) Well No. 48 located at a standard oil well location 560 feet from the North line and 1980 feet from the West line of said Section 29.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of General Rule 104 F(I) both of the following described unorthodox oil well locations are hereby approved.

Turner "B" Well No. 89 30' FNL - 1350' FWL; and

Turner "B" Well No. 90 75' FNL - 2610' FWL.
