*Amended Administrative Order NSL-2980*

Dear Mr. Newport:

Reference is made to your letter dated February 12, 1991 requesting to amend the location of the Lovington Paddock Unit Well No. 88 which was approved by Division Administrative Order NSL-2980, dated January 17, 1991, to be 1605 feet from the North line and 265 feet from the West line (Unit E) of Section 31, Township 16 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lovington Paddock Pool, Lovington Paddock Waterflood Project Area, Lea County, New Mexico.

It is our understanding that said amendment is at the request of the U.S. Bureau of Land Management, which is the surface management agency for this drilling tract. Therefore, by authority granted me under the provisions of General Rule 104.F.I., said order is hereby amended to reflect the location of the No. 88 well as "1642 feet from the North line and 302 feet from the West line."

All other provisions of said Administrative Order NSL-2980 shall remain in full force and effect until further notice.
