
Dear Mr. Baxter:

Reference is made to your application dated December 5, 1990 for a non-standard gas well location for your Bond Federal Well No. 1E to be located 2195 feet from the South line and 2165 feet from the East line (Unit J) of Section 13, Township 26 North, Range 8 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico.

It is our understanding that said well will be dually completed in the Basin Dakota Pool and Ballard Pictured Cliffs Pool, whereby the S/2 of said Section 13 will be dedicated to the Dakota zone and the SE/4 well will be dedicated to the Pictured Cliffs zone.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of General Rule 104.F.II. and Rule 2(c) of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Dakota Pool as promulgated by Division Order R-8170, as amended, the above-described unorthodox gas well location is hereby approved.
