Reference is made to your application dated January 23, 1991 for a non-standard gas well location for your Scott E. Federal 23 Well No. 42 to be located 1620 feet from the North line and 330 feet from the East line (Unit H) of Section 23, Township 27 North, Range 11 West, NMPM, West Kutz-Pictured Cliffs Gas Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico. The NE/4 of said Section 23 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 160-acre standard spacing and proration unit.
