Dear Mr. Seltzer:

Reference is made to your application dated April 12, 1991 for a non-standard gas well location for your Conastoga State Well No. 1 to be located 660 feet from the South line and 990 feet from the East line (Unit P) of Section 14, Township 8 South, Range 27 East, NMPM, to test the Ordovician formation, Chaves County, New Mexico. The S/2 of said Section 14 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit.
