
Dear Mr. Howard:

Reference is made to your applications dated March 19 and 26, 1991 for five unorthodox oil well locations for the purpose of completing an efficient injection/production pattern within your Central Vacuum Unit Pressure Maintenance Project, established by Division Order No. R-5530, dated August 17, 1977. The following described wells are to be located in either Section 31, township 17 South, Range 34 East, NMPM, or Section 31, Township 17 South, Range 35 East, NMPM, Vacuum Grayburg-San Andres Pool, Central Vacuum Unit Area, Lea County, New Mexico.
