

Dear Mr. Miller:

Reference is made to your application dated May 20, 1991 for a non-standard oil well location to permit the completion of an efficient production/injection pattern within an existing secondary recovery project for your G. J. West Co-op Unit Well No. 79 to be located 2310 feet from the North line and 1460 feet from the East line (Unit G) of Section 21, Township 17 South, Range 29 East, NMPM, Grayburg-Jackson Pool, G. J. West Co-op Unit Waterflood Project Area, Eddy County, New Mexico. Said well to be dedicated to the existing standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit comprising the SW/4 NE/4 of said Section 21, which is presently dedicated to its G. J. West Co-op Unit Well No. 37 located at a standard oil well location 1980 feet from the North and East lines of said Section 21.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of General Rule 104 F(I), the above-described unorthodox oil well location is hereby approved.
