Dear Mr. Miller:

Reference is made to your application dated June 17, 1991, for an unorthodox Blinebry gas well location in an existing non-standard 80-acre gas spacing and proration unit (GPU) for said Blinebry and Oil Gas Pool comprising the E/2 NE/4 of Section 9, Township 22 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. Said GPU was authorized by Division Administrative Order NSP-811, dated August 6, 1969 and presently has dedicated thereon the Brunson Argo Well No. 13. located in Unit A of said Section 9.

It is our understanding that the subject well to be considered at this time was recently recompleted from the Drinkard Pool to the Blinebry interval as a single completion.


By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 2(c) of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Blinebry Oil and Gas Pool, as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, the following described well located at an unorthodox gas well location in said Section 9 is hereby approved:

Brunson Argo Well No. 12
1909' FNL - 589' FEL (Unit H)

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Also, you are hereby authorized to simultaneously dedicate Blinebry Oil and Gas production from the Brunson Argo Well No. 12 with the Brunson Argo Well No. 13. Furthermore, you are hereby permitted to produce the allowable assigned the GPU from both of said wells in any proportion.
