Dear Mr. Bohling:

Reference is made to your application dated August 5, 1991, for an unorthodox Eumont gas well location in an existing non-standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit (GPU) for said Eumont Gas Pool comprising the E/2 of Section 25, Township 19 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. Said GPU was authorized by Division Administrative Order NSP-213, dated December 16, 1955 and had dedicated thereon the Graham State (NCT-C) Com Well No. 8 located at a standard gas well location in Unit J of said Section 25.

By Division Order R-6921, dated March 15, 1982, an additional well for said GPU, the Graham State (NCT-C) Com Well No. 9 located in Unit B of said Section 25 was approved.


By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 2(c) of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Eumont Gas Pool, as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, the following described well to be drilled at an unorthodox gas well location is hereby approved:

Graham State (NCT-C) Com Well No. 11
1055' FSL - 660' FEL (Unit P)

Also, you are hereby authorized to simultaneously dedicate Eumont Gas production from the Graham State Com Well No. 11 with the Graham State (NCT-T) Com Well Nos. 8 and 9. Furthermore, you are hereby permitted to produce the allowable assigned the GPU from all of said wells in any proportion.
