Dear Mr. Stogner:

Mewbourne Oil Company finds it necessary to apply for and receive an unorthodox location in order to drill its Sullivan #1 located in the east half of Section 10, T17S, R26E, Eddy County, New Mexico. The reasons for the location at 990' FSL and 660' FEL of Section 10 are two-fold. First this location will give Mewbourne Oil the opportunity to encounter the greatest possible thickness of Morrow "A" Sand. Secondly, the location also gives Mewbourne Oil a secondary objective in the Morrow "B" Sand with a possible thickness great enough to be commercially productive.

The Morrow "A" Sand isopach map shows the projected trend of the channel sand which produces in Mewbourne Oil's Vogel #1 in the SW/4SW/4 of Section 14. The edges of this channel do not have the permeability required to provide commercial production as evidenced by the well in the SW/4SE/4 of Section 15 and the well in the NE/4SW/4 of Section 14. There are no wells north of these three which have encountered the Morrow "A" Sand. Mewbourne Oil drilled its Haldeman #1 in the SW/4NW/4 of Section 14 with this sand as a primary objective but did not find the sand. The proposed location has a significant amount of risk for the Morrow "A" Sand. If the proposed well encounters a great enough thickness of this sand, Mewbourne Oil expects to be able to make an economic completion.


The Haldeman #1 did encounter the Morrow "B" Sand and has been completed as a commercial producer. The Morrow "B" Sand isopach map projects the Mewbourne Oil Sullivan #1 will encounter approximately 20' of this sand. The well in Section 10 which encountered 30' of net productive sand has produced 393 MMCFG and 1589 BBLS of condensate in 9 years. This would not provide a profit. The well in Section 11 which encountered 12 feet of productive sand made 30 MMCFG and 105 BBLS of condensate in two years before being abandoned. This would not justify a completion attempt. The proposed location has less risk for the Morrow "B" Sand; however, the production history of this sand in the immediate area does not provide an economic return on investment although it should allow Mewbourne Oil to recover the cost of drilling the well. The orthodox location marked "X" would not provide enough thickness in this sand to expect production any better than the poor well in Section 11.

The enclosed cross section E to E' shows the correlation of the key wells used to define the mapped sands.

Mewbourne Oil Company believes the proposed unorthodox location for its Sullivan #1 is reasonable and necessary to the orderly development of this area. It also believes this location provides it the best opportunity of encountering a thickness of the primary objective Morrow "A" Sand great enough to be economical and a thickness of the secondary objective Morrow "B" Sand great enough to offset the well costs and thus reduce the overall risks. Enclosed are three (3) sets of the geological and land exhibits supporting this unorthodox location application.

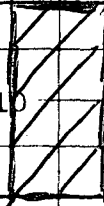



Dear Ms. Mathes:

I am in receipt of your objection by letter dated September 17, 1991 to the subject application. The well in which your objection is directed was filed pursuant to Division General Rule 104.F.(2) which allows an operator to seek administrative authorization for an unorthodox gas well location spaced on 320-acres, provided said location is no closer than 660 feet from the nearest side boundary nor closer than 990 feet to the nearest end boundary of the designated spacing and proration unit.

It appears to the Division at this time that Mewbourne Oil Company has met all of the requirements in filing this application per General Rules 104.F(3) and (4) as it relates to their proposed well in the E/2 of said Section 10.

It is my understanding that you are the owner of the unleased mineral interest in the N/2 NE/4 of Section 3, Township 17 South, Range 26 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico, therefore the southern most portion of your acreage is located 8250 feet (1 and 9/16 miles) from the proposed unorthodox well location. Statewide Spacing Rules (see 104.C.(2)) allows gas well locations on 320-acre spacing, to be no closer than 1980 feet to the nearest end boundary. In this instance a well in the E/2 of Section 10 could be drilled without notifying any off-setting parties a distance of 1980 feet from the North line of said Section 10 or a distance of 5940 feet (1 and 1/8 mile) from your mineral interest. Since the proposed well is moving away from your acreage instead of closer, it appears that the N/2 NE/4 of Section 3 would suffer no adverse effects due to drainage. Your objection is therefore deemed inapplicable at this time and the NMOCDD shall therefore proceed in processing the subject application of Mewbourne administratively.
