I received your note (attached) and after researching your concern I discovered that we had filed a sundry on October 17, 1995 advising that we planned to plug the Mesaverde and recomplete to the Fruitland Coal in the Sanchez Gas Com C #1 (Unit A Sec 28 T29N-R10W). However, on October 31, 1996 we filed a notice of intent to plug and abandon the Sanchez Gas Com "C" #1 instead of recompleting. This notice of intent was approved on November 4, 1996. To allay any confusion, I asked our permitting agent to file an additional sundry (attached) to make sure you were aware that we had no plans to recomplete the Sanchez well. I hope that this clears up the concern which you had about approving the Chapson well in this section as a Fruitland Coal completion at an unorthodox location.



I have reviewed your letter dated November 21, 1996 regarding our application for an unorthodox coal gas location for this well. Your are correct that the "1R" designation indicates that this is a replacement well. There was an original well known as the Pollock Com "E" #1 (API 3004525743) located in Unit P Section 28-T29N-R10W which was completed in the Fruitland Coal. According to the computer records of your Aztec District, this well had a nonstandard location order issued under order number NSL-3064 for the Basin Fruitland Coal. This well has been plugged and abandoned by Amoco and is reflected in the Aztec District computer database as Plugged and Abandoned. As to the status of the order, since the well for which the order was sought is plugged and abandoned, I believed that a new order was required to cover this replacement well. Should this well be covered under the original order please advise. The Aztec District computer records show no other orders for Fruitland Coal in this 320-acre spacing unit.



Dear Ms. Staley:

The designation "R" in a well number usually signifies this well to be a replacement well. Your application gave no information or indication that this was the case. In looking up this omitted material I came across references to previous Fruitland coal gas activity within this section. To assure that all rules and regulations are being complied with and to eliminate the possibility of misunderstandings that could lead to a rule infraction, please supplement this application with copies of or references to all previous orders issued within the subject 320-acre area for Fruitland coal gas production. Further provide a narrative as to the status of these orders and related well completions.
