Dear Bill:

Reference is made to your application dated October 1, 1991 for a non-standard Basin-Fruitland coal gas well location for your existing Michener "A" LS Well No. 5A which was drilled in 1985 and completed in the Blanco Mesaverde Pool at a standard gas well location 1190 feet from the North line and 790 feet from the West line (Unit D) of Section 31, Township 28 North, Range 9 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico.

It is my understanding that the Mesaverde zone will be properly plugged back and said well will be recompleted to the Basin-Fruitland Coal Gas Pool, which pursuant to the Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Fruitland Coal Gas Pool as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8768, as amended, is unorthodox. Further, Lots 1 and 2, the NE/4 and E/2 NW/4 (N/2 equivalent) of said Section 31 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 303.22-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 8 of the Division Order No. R-8768, as amended, the above described unorthodox coal gas well location is hereby approved.
