National Cooperative Refinery Association requests administrative approval for an unorthodox location for the subject well. NCRA is utilizing an unorthodox location due to topographic limitations.

Attachment 2 is a land plat showing offset wells and their operators.


Attachment 3 is a topographic map showing the proposed location and the proration unit. National Cooperative Refinery Association's original location was in the center of the SE/SW of Section 32. A road to the original location would have been very expensive to build due to the steep and rocky terrain. Because of the difficulty in building the road to location, NCRA requests an unorthodox location for the subject well. There are no wells located in Section 32 so an existing well pad cannot be utilized.

A 12-1/4" hole will be drilled to 250'. Surface casing will be run and cemented to surface. A 3000 psi BOP will be installed and a 7-7/8" hole will be to 6700' with a fresh water mud system. NCRA will log the well. Production casing will be run and cemented to surface. Two 30' cores are planned at approximately 5800'.
