Reference is made to your application dated November 27, 1991 for a non-standard oil well location for your Federal I Well No. 6 to be located 1270 feet from the North line and 640 feet from the West line (Unit D) of Section 21, Township 23 North, Range 7 West, NMPM, Undesignated Lybrook-Gallup Oil Pool, Sandoval County, New Mexico. The NW/4 NW/4 of said Section 21 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit for said pool.
