Reference is made to your application dated November 14, 1991 for a non-standard oil well location for your State "J" Well No. 5 to be located 1170 feet from the North line and 2040 feet from the West line (Unit C) of Section 16, Township 23 North, Range 7 West, NMPM, Lybrook-Gallup Oil Pool, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.
