Reference is made to your application dated November 4, 1991 for a non-standard coal gas well location for your Rosa Unit Well No. 361 to be located 980 feet from the South line and 2500 feet from the West line (Unit N) of Section 26, Township 31 North, Range 5 West, NMPM, Basin Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. The W/2 of said Section 26 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.
