Reference is made to your application dated March 23, 1992 for a non-standard oil well location to permit the completion of an efficient production/injection pattern within an active secondary recovery project for your Lovington Paddock Unit Well No. 140 to be located 2522 feet from the North line and 2630 feet from the West line (Unit F) of Section 1, Township 17 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lovington Paddock Pool, Lovington Paddock Waterflood Project Area, Lea County, New Mexico.
