Reference is made to your application on behalf of Parker & Parsley Petroleum Company dated May 26, 1992 for a non-standard coal gas well location for the Rosa Unit Well No. 294 to be located 1066 feet from the South line and 987 feet from the East line (Unit P) of Section 10, Township 31 North, Range 4 West, NMPM, Basin Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. The S/2 of said Section 10 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 8 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8768, as amended, the above-described unorthodox coal gas well location is hereby approved.
