
Dear Mr. Kelldorf:

Reference is made to your application dated July 27, 1992 for two non-standard oil well locations to permit the completion of an efficient production/injection pattern within North Hobbs Grayburg-San Andres Unit Pressure Maintenance Project, established by Division Order No. R-6199, dated November 30, 1979, North Hobbs Grayburg-San Andres Unit, Hobbs Grayburg-San Andres Pool.
