*Amended Administrative Order NSL-3148*

Dear Mr. Winder:

Reference is made to your application dated May 5, 1993 to amend Division Administrative Order NSL-3148, dated August 20, 1992 for an alternate location for the North Hobbs Grayburg-San Andres Unit Section 32 Well No. 144 to comply with additional surface use restrictions within the city limits of Hobbs, New Mexico that necessitate the re-staking of the subject location.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Division General Rule 104.F.(1), said Administrative Order NSL-3148 is hereby amended to reflect the location for the No. 144 well to be "786 feet from the South line and 1175 feet from the West line (Unit M) of Section 32, Township 18 South, Range 38 East, NMPM, North Hobbs Grayburg-San Andres Unit Pressure Maintenance Project, North Hobbs Grayburg-San Andres Unit, Hobbs Grayburg-San Andres Pool, Lea County, New Mexico. All other provisions of said Order NSL-3148 shall remain in full force and effect until further notice.
