Dear Ms. Perez:

Reference is made to your application dated July 30, 1992 for an unorthodox Jalmat gas well location in an existing non-standard 480-acre gas spacing and proration unit (GPU) for said Jalmat Gas Pool comprising the E/2 SE/4 of Section 19 and the E/2 and E/2 NW/4 of Section 30, both in Township 25 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. Said GPU was authorized by Division Order No. R-7525, dated May 15, 1984, and is presently simultaneously dedicated to the following five wells.


It is my understanding that the subject well in this application is temporarily abandoned in the Seven Rivers interval of the Jalmat Oil Pool and upon issuance of this order will be recompleted in the Yates formation of the Jalmat Gas Pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 2(c) of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Eumont Gas Pool, as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, the following described well located at an unorthodox gas well location is hereby approved:

Winningham Well No. 6  
660' FS & EL (Unit P) of  
said Section 30

Also, you are hereby authorized to simultaneously dedicate Jalmat Gas production from the Winningham Well No. 6 with the Winningham Well Nos. 1, 2, 7, 8 and 9. Furthermore, you are hereby permitted to produce the allowable assigned the subject GPU from all of said wells in accordance with the provisions set fourth by Decretory Paragraph No. (2) of said Order No. R-7525.
