Dear Mr. Irwin:

Reference is made to your application dated September 29, 1992 for a non-standard gas well location in the Basin-Dakota Pool for the Rincon Unit Well No. 130E located 2040 feet from the South line and 2060 feet from the East line (Unit J) of Section 32, Township 27 North, Range 6 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. The existing gas spacing and proration unit comprising the W/2 of said Section 32 shall be dedicated to the well.

It is our understanding said well is to be dually completed with the Undesignated South Blanco-Tocito Oil Pool in which the W/2 SE/4 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 81.4-acre oil spacing and proration unit. The above-referenced well location is standard for said pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 2(d) of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Dakota Pool as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, the above-described unorthodox gas well location is hereby approved.
