Reference is made to your application dated November 3, 1992 for a non-standard coal gas well location for your San Juan 32-7 Unit Well No. 238 to be located 518 feet from the North line and 2313 feet from the East line (Unit B) of Section 29, Township 32 North, Range 7 West, NMPM, Basin Fruitland Coal Gas Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico.
