Dear Mr. Brand:

Reference is made to your application dated November 9, 1992 for a non-standard Hobbs Lower-Blinbry oil well location for your existing State "G" Well No. 6 which was drilled in 1969, ultimately drilled to a depth of 7041 feet and currently completed in the Hobbs Paddock Pool at a standard oil well location 1980 feet from the North line and 1650 feet from the West line (Unit F) of Section 33, Township 18 South, Range 38 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

It is my understanding that the Paddock zone will be properly plugged back and said well will be recompleted to the Hobbs Lower-Blinbry Pool, which pursuant to the Special Rules and Regulations for the Hobbs Lower-Blinbry Pool as promulgated by Division Order No. R-9696, is unorthodox. Further, the S/2 NW/4 of said Section 33 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 80-acre oil spacing and proration unit for said pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 5 of said Division Order No. R-9696, the above-described unorthodox oil well location is hereby approved.
