Dear Mr. O'Hare:

Reference is made to your application dated January 20, 1993 for a non-standard coal gas well location for your Gallegos Federal 26-13-11 Well No. 1, which was drilled in December 1992 and located 2050 feet from the North line and 790 feet from the East line (Unit H) of Section 11, Township 26 North, Range 13 West, NMPM, Basin Fruitland Coal Gas Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico. The N/2 of said Section 11 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 8 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8768, as amended, the above-described unorthodox coal gas well location is hereby approved.
