Dear Mr. LeMay:

Chevron U.S.A. is planning to recomplete the Harry Leonard (NCT-A) #6 in the Eumont YTS-7RVRS-QN (Pro Gas) Pool. The well, which is currently completed in the Eumont Oil (Queen) Pool, is located 660' FSL and 1980' FWL in Section 22, T-21-S, R-36-E, Lea County, New Mexico.

The subject well is located on an existing non-standard 480-acre Eumont Gas Spacing and Proration Unit (GPU) which comprises the E/2 and SW/4 of Section 22 according to Administrative Order NSP-944 dated April 12, 1974, and Division Order R-5549 dated October 25, 1977. Four wells on the aforementioned GPU, the Harry Leonard (NCT-A) Nos. 3, 7, 12 and 13, are currently dedicated to the We respectfully request that the production from the Harry Leonard (NCT-A) #6 be simultaneously dedicated to the aforementioned GPU with these four wells.

Because the subject well is located less than 990' from the boundary of the said 480-acre GPU, we also request your approval for an unorthodox well location.

A copy of this administrative application is being provided to our offset operators via Certified Mail. Attached is a commercial map, a proration unit map, and a Form C-102 Plat. Also included is a copy of Division Order R-5549 and Administrative Order NSP-944, as well as copies of the letters to our offset operators.





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

IN THE MATTER OF THE HEARING CALLED BY THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION OF NEW MEXICO FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSIDERING:

CASE NO. 6041 Order No. R-5549

APPLICATION OF GULF OIL CORPORATION FOR AN UNORTHODOX LOCATION, AND SIMULTANEOUS DEDICATION, LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO.



ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 a.m. on September 28, 1977, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Daniel S. Nutter.

NOW, on this 25th day of October, 1977, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony, the record, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That the applicant, Gulf Oil Corporation, seeks approval of an unorthodox gas well location for its Harry Leonar NCT-A Well No. 12 located in Unit P of Section 22, Township 21 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Eumont Gas Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.
- (3) That applicant further proposes to simultaneously dedicate the above-described well to a previously approved 480-acre non-standard proration unit comprising the SW/4 and E/2 of said Section 22 which is presently dedicated to applicant's Harry Leonard NCT-A Wells Nos. 3 and 7, located, respectively, in Units B and M of said Section 22.
- (4) That approval of the subject application will afford the applicant the opportunity to produce its just and equitable share of the gas in the subject pool, will prevent the economic loss caused by the drilling of unnecessary wells, avoid the augmentation of risk arising from the drilling of an excessive number of wells, and will otherwise prevent waste and protect correlative rights.

(5) That Commission Order NSP-944, dated April 4, 1974, which previously approved the subject unit, should be superseded.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- (1) That an unorthodox gas well location for the Gulf Oil Corporation Harry Leonard NCT-A Well No. 12 located in Unit P of Section 22, Township 21 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Eumont Gas Pool, Lea County, New Mexico, is hereby approved, said well to be simultaneously dedicated with applicant's Harry Leonard NCT-A Well Nos. 3 and 7, located in Units B and M, respectively, of said Section 22, to a previously approved 480-acre multiple well non-standard proration unit comprising the SW/4 and E/2 of said Section 22.
 - (2) That Commission Order NSP-944 is hereby superseded.
- (3) That jurisdiction of this cause is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
