

Dear Pecorine:

Reference is made to your applications dated May 10 and 26, 1993 for a non-standard coal gas well location for your Texakoma-Rio Arriba Well No. 1 to be drilled 1280 feet from the South line and 510 feet from the West line (Unit M) of Section 11, Township 29 North, Range 5 West, NMPM, Basin Fruitland Coal Gas Pool, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. The S/2 of said Section 11 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 8 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8768, as amended, the above-described unorthodox coal gas well location is hereby approved.
