Reference is made to your application dated June 2, 1993 for a non-standard oil well location for the purpose of completing an efficient production/injection pattern within the Rhodes Yates Waterflood Project Area, established by Division Order No. R-4521, dated May 17, 1963.

It is our understanding that the proposed Rhodes Yates Unit Well No. 17 is to be drilled 1302 feet from the North line and 46 feet from the West line (Unit D) of Section 27, Township 26 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Rhodes-Yates Pool, Rhodes Yates Project Area, Lea County, New Mexico.

The NW/4 NW/4 of said Section 27 shall be dedicated to said well forming a standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of General Rule 104 F(1), the abovedescribed unorthodox oil well location is hereby approved.
