
Dear Mr. Kolbe:

Reference is made to your application dated June 15, 1993, 1992 for a non-standard Basin-Fruitland coal gas well location for your existing Gallegos Canyon Unit Well No. 13 which was drilled in 1952 and completed in the West Kutz-Pictured Cliffs Pool at a standard gas well location at the time said well was drilled 660 feet from the South and West lines (Unit M) of Section 27, Township 28 North, Range 12 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico.

It is my understanding that the Pictured Cliffs zone will be properly plugged back and said well will be recompleted to the Basin-Fruitland Coal Gas Pool, which pursuant to the Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Fruitland Coal Gas Pool as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8768, as amended, is unorthodox. Further, the W/2 of said Section 27 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 8 of said Division Order No. R-8768, as amended, the above-described unorthodox coal gas well location is hereby approved.
