Dear Mr. Basham:

Reference is made to your application dated June 10, 1993 for a non-standard oil well location for the purpose of completing an efficient production/injection pattern within the Texaco Rhodes "B" Federal Waterflood Project Area, established by Division Order No. R-2748, dated July 29, 1964.

It is our understanding that the proposed W.H. Rhodes Federal "B" NCT-1 Well No. 31 is to be drilled 1165 feet from the South line and 2629 feet from the East line (Unit O) of Section 26, Township 26 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Rhodes Yates-Seven Rivers Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

Said well to be dedicated to the existing standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit comprising the SW/4 SE/4 of said Section 26, which is currently dedicated to the W.H. Rhodes Federal "B" NCT-1 Well No. 12, located at a standard oil well location 660 feet from the South line and 1980 feet from the East line of said Section 26.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of General Rule 104 F(I), the above-described unorthodox oil well location is hereby approved.
