Dear Mr. Correa:

Reference is made to your application dated June 8, 1993 for a non-standard San Andres gas well location for your existing New Mexico "V" Well No. 10 which was drilled in 1952 and completed as an oil well in the Wantz Abo, Drinkard and Hare Simpson Pools at a standard location 560 feet from the South line and 660 feet from the West line (Unit M) of Section 10, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

It is my understanding that said well will be recompleted to the Undesignated Hare-San Andres Gas Pool, which pursuant to Division General Rule 140.C(2)(a), is unorthodox. Further, the SW/4 of said Section 10 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 160-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 104.F(1), the above-described unorthodox gas well location is hereby approved.
