The New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (OCD) has received the Site Investigation Report for the Plains Red Byrd #1 / Red Byrd Historical Release Site (1R0085), dated May, 2008, and has conducted a review of the report. However, the OCD recommends that an additional groundwater monitoring well be installed ~160 feet to the southeast of MW-15. The initial sampling should include the parameters as specified in the attached list.
